The board recognizes that volunteers (i.e., parents, students, senior citizens, and other adults) can make many valuable contributions. Therefore, the board endorses a volunteer program in the district schools ¹ and encourages principals to design a volunteer program for each school.

The principal shall be responsible to ensure that appropriate recognition of volunteer services is made annually.

All volunteers must be approved by the principal and shall serve under the supervision and direction of the professional personnel of the school to whom they are assigned. Volunteers shall perform non-instructional work which serves to assist professional personnel in the performance of teaching and administrative responsibilities and may include, but shall not be limited to, activities such as teacher's aide, library assistant, lunch room monitor, hall monitor, and recreation aide.

Volunteers shall not be employees of the district and shall serve without compensation of any type.

In all cases, the responsible school person shall retain the final authority over students, school programs, and services.
