- It is essential that the teaching *about* religion and not *of* a religion be conducted in a factual, objective,
 and respectful manner in accordance with the following guidelines:
- Music, art, literature or drama with a religious theme or basis is permitted as part of the
 curriculum for school-sponsored activities and programs provided it is essential to the learning
 experience in the various fields of study and is presented objectively;
- 6 2. The inclusion of religion shall be for educational purposes only;¹
- The emphasis on religious themes in the arts, literature and history should be only as extensive as necessary for a balanced and comprehensive study of the curriculum. Such studies shall never be used to proselytize, establish, foster, or demean any particular religion, religious tenets, or beliefs; and¹
- Student-initiated expressions to questions or assignments which reflect their beliefs or nonbeliefs about a religious theme shall be accommodated. For example, students are free to express religious belief or non-belief in compositions, art forms, music, speech and debate.
