- 1 The Board expects all school staff, students and parents to assume the responsibility for appropriate behaviors in
2 the school.
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- 4 Each student has the right to:
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- 6 1. Have the opportunity for a free education in the most appropriate learning environment;
 - 7 2. Be secure in his/her person, papers and effects against unreasonable searches and seizure;
 - 8 3. Expect that the school will be a safe place;
 - 9 4. Have an appropriate environment conducive to learning;
 - 10 5. Not be discriminated against on the basis of sex, race, color, creed, religion, national origin or disabilities; and
 - 11 6. Be fully informed of school rules and regulations.
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- 13 Each student has the responsibility to (TCA 49-6-3401):
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- 15 1. Know and adhere to reasonable rules and regulations established by the Board and school;
 - 16 2. Respect the human dignity and worth of every other individual;
 - 17 3. Refrain from libel, slanderous remarks, and obscenity in verbal and written expression;
 - 18 4. Study and maintain the best possible level of academic achievement;
 - 19 5. Be punctual and present in the regular school program;
 - 20 6. Dress and groom in a manner that meets reasonable standards of health, cleanliness, modesty and safety;
 - 21 7. Maintain and/or improve the school environment, preserve school and private property, and exercise care
 - 22 while using school facilities;
 - 23 8. Refrain from behavior which would lead to physical or emotional harm or which disrupts the educational
 - 24 process;
 - 25 9. Respect the authority of school administrators, teachers and other authorized personnel in maintaining disci-
 - 26 pline in the school and at school-sponsored activities;
 - 27 10. Obey the law and school rules as to the possession or the use of alcohol, illegal drugs and other unauthorized
 - 28 substances or materials; and
 - 29 11. Possess on school grounds only those materials which are acceptable under the law and to accept the conse-
 - 30 quences for articles stored in one's locker.
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
