- 1 The school bus is an extension of school activity; therefore, students shall conduct themselves on the bus
- 2 in a manner consistent with the established standards for safety and classroom behavior.
- 3 Students are under the supervision and control of the bus driver while on his/her bus, and all reasonable
- 4 directions given by him/her shall be followed. A driver may remove a student in the event that the driver
- 5 finds it necessary for the safety of the other student passengers or the driver, provided that the driver
- 6 secures the safety of the ejected student for the uncompleted trip. A driver shall report to school
- 7 authorities as soon as possible, but no later than the end of the route, any student refusing to obey the
- 8 driver or exiting the bus without the driver's permission at a point other than the student's destination
- 9 for that trip.²
- 10 In order to maintain conditions and atmosphere suitable for learning, no person shall enter onto a school
- bus except students assigned to that bus or parent(s)/guardian(s) of students or other persons with lawful
- and valid business on the bus, school staff or approved chaperones.¹
- 13 The principal of the student transported shall be informed by the bus driver of any serious discipline
- problem and may be called upon to assist if necessary. A student may be denied the privilege of riding
- the bus if the principal determines that his/her behavior is such as to cause disruption on the bus or if
- he/she disobeys applicable policies and procedures pertaining to student transportation.
- Any student who gets off the bus at any point between the pick-up point and school shall present the bus
- driver with a note of authorization from the parent/guardian or the principal of the school that the student
- 19 attends.

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- 20 Any student wishing to ride a bus other than his/her designated bus shall have written parental permission
- and the approval of the principal/designee.
- 22 Students who transfer from bus to bus while in route to and from school shall be expected to abide by
- 23 the discipline policies adopted by the Board and procedures maintained by the terminal school.
- 24 Students in violation of bus conduct rules shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with
- 25 established Board policy and regulations governing student conduct and discipline.

USE OF VIDEO CAMERAS

- 27 Video cameras may be used to monitor student behavior on school vehicles while transporting students
- 28 to and from school or extracurricular activities. Video surveillance shall be used only to promote the
- order, safety and security of students, staff and property.

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The district shall comply with all applicable state and federal laws related to photographs and video 1

- footage.³ These materials shall be maintained for a minimum of five (5) calendar days, but maybe saved 2
- digitally if the need arises. Access to viewing recordings will be limited to school administrators and 3
- their designee for investigative or management needs only. All requests for viewing video footage must 4
- be sent to the Director of Schools in writing, by subpoena or through an Order of the Court. 5
- 6 The Director of Schools shall develop procedures governing the use of cameras and video cameras in
- 7 accordance with the provisions of state and federal law.
