1 General¹

- 2 The Board shall operate an alternative school and/or program for students who have been suspended or
- 3 expelled from the regular school program. Attendance in the alternative school program shall be
- 4 mandatory and bus transportation may be provided, on a hardship basis, at the discretion of the Director
- 5 of Schools or his/her designee.
- 6 An alternative school is a short-term intervention program designed to provide educational services
- outside the regular school program for students who have been suspended or expelled. The alternative
 school is located in a separate facility from the regular school program.
- 9 Teachers in alternative schools shall be certified by the state and shall be selected on the basis of
- 10 interest and ability to work in alternative situations. Student –teacher ratios shall be small enough to
- 11 allow for adequate instruction but shall be determined by age, behavior and academic achievement of
- 12 students in the program.
- 13 Sufficient textbooks, equipment, instructional materials, and supplies shall be provided by the home
- 14 school.
- 15 The alternative school and/or program shall be operated in accordance with state laws and the rules of
- 16 the State Board of Education, and instruction shall proceed as nearly as practicable in accordance with
- 17 the instructional program at the student's regular school. All course work completed and credits
- 18 earned in the alternative school shall be transferred to and recorded in the student's home school.
- 19 Credit earned and progress made shall be granted as if the work were performed in the home school.
- 20 The Director of Schools shall develop procedures that provide appropriate educational opportunities
- for all students assigned to the alternative school or program. These educational opportunities shall
- 22 adhere to Tennessee's academic standards.²

23 ASSIGNMENT

- 24 Students who have been suspended for more than ten (10) days or expelled shall be assigned to the
- alternative school or program if there is staff and space available.³ Availability of staff and space shall
- 26 be determined at the time the disciplinary decision is rendered. The Director of Schools/designee shall

- 2 1. Level of supervision available;
- 3 2. Safety considerations; and
- 4 3. Type of infraction.
- Students who have committed zero tolerance offenses are not required to be assigned to alternative
 schools or programs.⁴
- 7 Prior to the assignment of the student to the alternative school or program, the Director of
- 8 Schools/designee shall provide written notice to the student's parent/guardian stating the reason for the
- 9 student's placement.⁵
- 10 Placement in an alternative education setting shall be reserved for students who significantly disrupt
- 11 the educational process. If a student has an active Individualized Education Plan, a 504 plan, or is
- suspected of having a disability, all state and federal laws and rules and regulations related to special
- education shall be followed. The Director of Schools/designee shall develop procedures regarding
- 14 placement of students in the program, taking into consideration the impact of exclusionary discipline
- 15 practices.⁶
- The Director of Schools/designee shall monitor and regularly evaluate the academic progress of eachstudent enrolled in the alternative school.
- Students found to be eligible for special education in related circumstances shall be placed and servedin accordance with the law and rules relating to special education.
- 20 REMOVAL⁷
- A student may be removed from the alternative school or program if:
- 1. He/she violates the rules of the alternative school or program; or
- 23 2. He/she is not benefitting from the assignment and all interventions have been exhausted24 unsuccessfully.
- 25 ADDITIONAL OFFENSES⁸
- Any new disciplinary offense committed during a student's original suspension or expulsion period shall be treated as a new and separate offense. These offenses shall not constitute an extension of the original suspension or expulsion.

TRANSITION PLAN⁹ 1

- The Director of Schools/designee shall develop procedures regarding the implementation of transition 2
- 3 plans for the integration of students assigned to the alternative school.
