1 The administration will establish a plan to identify migratory students in the district, as required by law,
2 and to ensure that migrant students receive services for which they are eligible. (PL 107-110 Part C §§
3 1301-1309) In developing and implementing a program to address the needs of migratory students the
4 district will:

- 6 1. Identify migratory students and assess the educational and related health and social needs of each
7 student.
- 8 2. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs, special
9 education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling programs,
10 elective classes, fine arts classes, etc.
- 11 3. Provide migratory children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment standards
12 that all students are expected to meet.
- 13 4. To the extent feasible, provide advocacy and outreach programs to migratory students and their
14 families and professional development for district staff.
- 15 5. Provide parents an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.

17 If a migrant student is identified by the district, the Director of Schools/designee will notify the State
18 Department and request assistance if needed.
