In the e-mail, send a picture of the front of the driver's license of the person who is requesting the account. When the account is verified, you will receive an e-mail with login info and be asked to reset the password.

Be sure to check out the Playbook for 2020-2021 Pre-K and Kindergarten Online Enrollment. This valuable resource will answer most questions you may have. The enrollment process will end on Wednesday, June 15. While school offices are officially closed for in-person business, office staff will be available to answer your questions by phone during the hours of 8:30-2:00 every Wednesday through May 20. On days other than Wednesday, the front desk at the Central Office (615-446-7571) will be able to answer general questions. You may also email the school principals.

Dickson County Schools are proud to be able to serve meals to students during the summer of 2020. Meals are provided free to children ages 0-18. Families *do not* need to provide proof of school enrollment, income, or free/reduced lunch eligibility. Children must be present to receive the meal.
