- 1 The Board will transact all business at official meetings which may be either regular or special.
- 2 Every meeting of the Board, except with the attorney to discuss pending or threatened litigation,
- 3 appeals of DHA decisions, negotiation strategy sessions, and school safety plans, will be open to the
- 4 public. Open meetings will be physically accessible to all students, employees, and interested
- 5 citizens.<sup>2</sup>
- 6 The Board may choose to restrict the presence of electronics or encourage the sharing of information
- 7 resources, such as video footage or equipment, in the interests of conducting efficient and orderly
- 8 public meetings.<sup>3</sup>
- 9 REGULAR MEETINGS
- 10 Regular meetings of the Board shall be held on the fourth Thursday of each month.
- In instances when any regular meeting date falls on a legal holiday, or other circumstances that may
- 12 necessitate change, the meeting shall be rescheduled by the chair.
- 13 SPECIAL MEETINGS
- 14 The Board shall hold such special meetings as necessary to transact the business of the Board. Such
- meetings shall be called by the chair whenever, in the chair's judgment, the interests of the schools
- require it, or when requested to do so by a majority of the Board.<sup>4</sup>
- Only business related to the call of the meeting, and details related to agenda items shall be discussed
- or transacted by the Board at a special meeting.
- 19 ELECTRONIC ATTENDNACE<sup>5</sup>
- 20 Absent board members may attend a regular or special meetings by electronic means for certain
- 21 qualifying reasons. The following requirements apply to all electronic attendance, regardless of the
- 22 reason for the absence:
- 1. A quorum of the Board shall be physically present at the meeting in order for the board member to attend electronically;
- 25 2. Any board member wishing to participate electronically shall do so using technology that allows the Chair to visually identify the board member; and

- 1 3. The responsibility for the connection lies with the board member wishing to participate
- electronically. No more than three (3) attempts to connect shall be made unless the Board chooses
- 3 to make additional attempts.
- 4 Work-Related Absence
- 5 A board member may attend a meeting by electric means if out of county due to work; however, he/she
- 6 may only participate electronically two (2) times per year for this reason. The board members shall
- 7 give the Chair and Director of Schools at least five (5) days' notice prior to the meeting of the board
- 8 member's intention to participate electronically.
- 9 Sickness or Period of Convalescence
- 10 A board member may attend a meeting by electronic means if sick or in a period of convalescence on
- the advice of a healthcare professional; however, he/she may only participate electronically three (3)
- times per year for this reason.
- 13 Inclement Weather or Natural Disaster
- 14 A board member may attend a meeting by electronic means due to inclement weather or natural
- disaster if the schools in the school district are closed; however he/she may only participate
- electronically three (3) times per year for this reason.
- 17 Family Emergency
- A board member may attend a meeting by electronic means if there is a family emergency that
- prevents him/her from attending in person. The absence shall be due to the hospitalization of eh board
- 20 member or the death or hospitalization of the member's spouse, father, mother, son, daughter, brother,
- sister, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, stepson, step daughter, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-
- law, or sister-in-law. The board member may only participate electronically two (2) times per year for
- this reason.
- 24 Military Service
- A board member may attend a meeting by electronic means if out of the county due to military service.
- The board member may participate electronically as often as he/she is able to do so.
