1 General

- 2 This policy shall apply to sponsors and potential sponsors of charter schools. It shall not apply to
- 3 charter schools converting from existing public schools. Proposals from existing charter school
- 4 operators or replicators and applicants proposing to contract with educational service providers shall
- 5 include the information required by state law.¹

6 APPLICATION PROCESS²

- 7 A prospective charter school sponsor shall send the Director of Schools notice of its intent sixty (60)
- 8 days prior to February 1st of the year preceding the year in which the proposed charter school plans to
- 9 begin operation as a charter school.
- 10 A sponsor seeking Dickson County Board of Education approval of an initial charter school
- application shall complete the forms provided by the Department of Education. The application shall
- provide all the information required by law. The sponsor shall demonstrate that the proposed charter
- school meets the purpose prescribed by law for the formation of a charter school, and the proposed
- charter school will be able to implement a viable program of quality education for its students.³
- 15 Applications shall be submitted to the Dickson County Board of Education and Department of
- Education on or before 4:30 p.m. on February 1st of the year preceding the year in which the proposed
- charter school plans to begin operation as a charter school. If the 1st of February falls on a Saturday,
- Sunday, or holiday on which the school district offices are closed, applications will be accepted on the
- 19 next business day on or before 4:30 p.m. Late applications will not be accepted, without exception. The
- sponsor shall pay an application fee of \$2,500.00.²

21 **REVIEW TEAM**¹

- 22 If necessary, the Dickson County Board of Education shall appoint a review team to assist in reviewing
- and evaluating charter school applications. The team shall be comprised of members of the
- 24 administrative staff for the district, community members, and a member of the Dickson County Board
- of Education with relevant educational, organizational, financial, and legal experience. If necessary,
- the Director of Schools shall make a recommendation to the Dickson County Board of Education on
- 27 which members of his/her administrative staff should be appointed to the team. The Dickson County
- 28 Board of Education shall name the members of the team at its meeting in January of each year. The
- 29 Dickson County Board of Education shall designate a Chair of the review team as the contact person
- 30 for answering questions about the application process and receiving applications. The Director of

1 Schools shall develop an orientation for the team to ensure consistent evaluation standards and the

- 2 elimination of real or perceived conflicts of interest
- 3 The Dickson County Board of Education shall require the Director of Schools to develop a procedure
- 4 for receiving, reviewing, and ruling on applications for the establishment of charter schools by the
- 5 review team. The procedure shall include a timeline for the application and review process. A copy of
- 6 the procedure, including the review criteria, shall be available to any interested party upon request.
- 7 The review team shall:

- 1. Evaluate all charter school applications based on the review criteria adopted by the Dickson County Board of Education;
- Recommend one of the following options to the Dickson County Board of Education for each application: approve, reject, or reject with stipulations for reconsideration; and
- 3. Make recommendations for revocation, renewal, or non-renewal of charter school contracts.

APPROVAL/DENIAL OF APPLICATION⁴

- 16 The Dickson County Board of Education shall rule by resolution on the approval or denial of a charter
- school application within ninety (90) days of receipt of the completed application, or the application
- shall be deemed approved by law. The Director of Schools shall report the action taken by the Dickson
- 19 County Board of Education to the Department of Education.
- 20 Approval
- 21 The sponsor of a charter school that is approved by the Dickson County Board of Education shall enter
- into a written agreement with the Dickson County Board of Education which shall be binding on the
- charter school's governing body. The charter school agreement shall be in writing and signed by the
- sponsor and the Dickson County Board of Education.
- 25 The Dickson County Board of Education will receive an annual authorizer fee of three percent (3%) of
- 26 the annual per student state and local allocations or thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), whichever is
- 27 less.⁵
- 28 Charter schools approved by the Dickson County Board of Education are expected to implement the
- 29 application as submitted and approved. Material variations in operations from the approved application
- 30 require amendment pursuant to statute and the charter school agreement.
- 31 The Dickson County Board of Education shall not provide services to charter schools that are not
- requested during the application process except for those services that are required under state or
- federal laws. Services agreed to be provided to the charter school by the Dickson County Board of
- 34 Education shall be provided at Dickson County Board of Education actual cost. The Dickson County
- 35 Board of Education and charter school shall execute a service contract for any additional services.

- New charter school agreements are approved for a ten (10) year period. The Dickson County Board of 1
- 2 Education may revoke or deny renewal of a charter school agreement for any of the reasons
- enumerated in state law.⁷ 3
- 4 Denial
- 5 Upon written receipt of the grounds for denial, the sponsor shall have thirty (30) days within which to
- submit an amended application to correct the deficiencies. The Dickson County Board of Education 6
- shall have sixty (60) days either to deny or to approve the amended application, or the application shall 7
- be deemed approved by law.⁴ 8
- 9 Within ten (10) days of final denial, an appeal may be filed with the State Dickson County Board of
- Education of Education. 10
