The Board recognizes the need for before and after school care. A child care program should be organized in each elementary school to give the care and protection the school-age child needs. The center should be a place for the child to choose learning activities, to receive help with homework, and to just enjoy socializing and relaxing in a climate created for children to be nurtured

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

Minimum guidelines as set forth by Public Chapter 37 will be adhered to in accounting for the Dickson County school-administered, school-age child care program.¹ The program will meet state standards for school-age child care.

Staff members for each school will be contracted by the principal and selected for their maturity, sense of responsibility, and for their sensibility to the needs of young people. Each staff member will undergo a special training program organized by the director of elementary education.
