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4 However, situations do exist, when students need to apprise themselves of an alternative format. This  
5 alternative format will generally be via an electronic form of delivery. All electronic courses shall  
6 meet Tennessee Standards and shall be approved by the Director of Schools/Designee.

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8 Such programs require students to possess skills of time management, organizational, self-regulation  
9 and self-direction. Dickson County Schools may offer an online, eLearning option for students in  
10 grades K-12. The program will initially accept applications for grades K-8 with the opportunity for  
11 students to continue and complete grades 9-12. Such programs will provide a rigorous online  
12 curriculum aligned to Tennessee State Learning Standards and will be taught by Tennessee Licensed  
13 Teachers.
