However, situations do exist, when students need to apprise themselves of an alternative format. This alternative format will generally be via an electronic form of delivery. All electronic courses shall meet Tennessee Standards and shall be approved by the Director of Schools/Designee.

Such programs require students to possess skills of time management, organizational, self-regulation and self-direction. Dickson County Schools may offer an online, eLearning option for students in grades K-12. The program will initially accept applications for grades K-8 with the opportunity for students to continue and complete grades 9-12. Such programs will provide a rigorous online curriculum aligned to Tennessee State Learning Standards and will be taught by Tennessee Licensed Teachers.
