Transfers Within the System

Transfer students will meet the same enrollment requirements as new students.

After a student has enrolled in one (1) school within the system, he/she will not be permitted to transfer to another unless there is a change in residence of the student's custodial parent(s) or legal guardian outside the area in which the student is enrolled.

The Director of Schools must approve any exception to this policy.

Students whose families move their residence to another school area after the month of school may complete the school year at their former school provided such move not affect regular school attendance. The Director of Schools may grant the request of a student who provides written evidence that he/she will move during the school year and who desires to transfer to another school within the county. The Director of Schools may grant other exceptions to this policy for good and sufficient reasons.

Principals shall allow credit for work transferred from other schools only when substantiated by official transcripts or successful completion of comprehensive written examinations approved, administered and graded by the principal/designee.¹
