PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS¹ 1

- The principal shall ensure that there is a complete physical examination of each student prior to:² 2
- 1. Entering Tennessee Public School for the first time. This applies to preschool, pre-k, kindergarten, 3
- first grade and other students for whom there is no health record¹ 4
- 5 2. Participation as a member of any athletic team or in any other strenuous physical activity program.³
- 6 Cost of the examination shall be borne by the parent/guardian of the student. These records shall be on
- file in the principal's/designee's office. 7
- 8 Screening test as required by the Tennessee Department of Education and the Tennessee Department
- of Health will be conducted. Parents/Guardians will receive written notice of any screening result that 9
- indicates a condition that might interfere or tend to interfere with a student's progress. In general, the 10
- district will not conduct physical examinations of a student without parental consent to do so or by 11
- court order, unless the health or safety of the student of others in is question.⁴ Parent/guardian may 12
- excuse their student from participating in health screenings that are part of a coordinated school health 13
- 14 program by submitting a request in writing to the school nurse, instructor, school counselor or
- principal⁵ 15

IMMUNIZATIONS 16

- 17 No students entering school, including those entering preschool, pre-k, kindergarten or first grade,
- those from out-of-state nor those from nonpublic schools, will be permitted to enroll (or attend) 18
- 19 without proof of immunization, as determined by the Commissioner of Public Health, unless
- circumstances outlined in state or federal law prevent a student from producing such records. It is the 20
- responsibility of the parents or guardians to have their children immunized and to provide such proof 21
- to the principal of the school which the student is to attend.⁶ 22
- Exceptions, in the absence of an epidemic or immediate threat thereof, will be granted to any child 23
- whose parent or guardian shall file with school authorities a signed, written statement that such 24

- 1 measures conflict with his/her religious tenets and practices⁷; or due to medical reasons if such child
- 2 has a written statement from his/her doctor excusing him from such immunization.⁸
- 3 Proof of exceptions will be in writing and filed in the same manner as other immunization records.
- 4 The Director of Schools shall ensure that appropriate immunization records are maintained for each
- 5 student.
