



# COVID-19 Procedure

## Staff and Students

Revised 8/16/2022

### Positive for COVID-19:

- Everyone with a positive COVID-19 result, regardless of vaccination status should stay home and isolate from others for a minimum of 5 days from symptom onset or positive test if asymptomatic.
  - Symptoms can be one or more of the following: cough, loss of taste and/or smell, fever, chills, congestion, sore throat, headache, fatigue, vomiting and/or diarrhea.
- On day 6 staff and students may return to school if symptoms are improving and fever-free for 24 hours.
- Students will receive an excused absence (C Code) in Skyward. If the student completes all assignments the student can be changed to present (G Code) in Skyward. Students should be encouraged to do all work so they will not be counted absent.

### CDC Recommendations for staff and students:

- Practice good hand hygiene and cover your mouth when sneezing or coughing.
- Monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 and get tested if symptoms are present.
- If positive, when returning to school student/staff should wear a mask through day 10. (not required by DCSTN).
- Wear a mask for 10 days after being exposed to someone with COVID-19. (not required by DCSTN).
