



Dickson County High School Student Dress Code Expectations 2024-2025

Students normally may wear only the following items during the school day:

- Sleeved shirts that cover cleavage and midriffs
- Pants that are free of holes and frays that show skin
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts that are beyond fingertips
- Proper undergarments that are not visible
- Appropriate shoes

Students may not wear the following:

- Cold shoulder or slit sleeve tops
- Sheer/see-through items
- Leggings (including athletic leggings, yoga pants, and flared leggings) unless tops are long enough to cover bottoms all the way around
- Bicycle shorts
- Clothes, buttons, backpacks, purses, accessories, etc. with questionable slogans such as tobacco, alcohol, or drug advertisements; the use of profanity; sexual connotations; or gang affiliation
- Costumes
- Body or face paint
- Blankets
- Sunglasses
- Hoods, hats, or other head coverings inside the buildings **(Hats should remain in the students' backpacks, vehicles, or at home.)**
- Pajamas or pajama-like articles
- House Shoes

Students shall dress and groom in a clean, neat, and modest manner so as not to distract or interfere with the educational environment of the school as determined by the administration.

Consequences of Violations

- 1st offense- Warning & Allow to change clothes (If change of clothes is not available, ISS will be assigned.)
- 2nd offense- 1 day of ISS
- 3rd offense- 1 day of ISS and parent conference

**Continued violations will result in possible NDA, OSS, and additional ISS.
