Thank you again for your continued support of our school system during this time. Your continued positive attitude, notes of encouragement, and seeking the best for your students have been such a blessing to our district- and building-level staff. As we stressed, it has been our two-fold goal to first take care of students' basic needs then to move toward providing resources to assist in keeping students engaged in the learning process.

Meals Service Program

Our school system will continue to provide free breakfast and lunch to our students. Resources have been published for daily drive-through meal service at selected schools and locations throughout our community. For those with extenuating circumstances, we are providing limited delivery service. Requests for delivery may be made by calling 615-740-5970. It is our intention to provide this service at least until the Friday before Memorial Day. Also, if your family is experiencing a need that our Student Services Department (counselors, nurses, school social workers, etc.) may assist you with, please feel free to contact our Central Office.

At-Home Learning Resources

Though our school buildings are closed, we are continuing to provide resources for your student to remain engaged. We will maintain our resources through May 22^{nd} . Be confident that the majority of our State standards have been taught prior to scheduled state testing. Please continue to combine the district-provided resources with other great resources such as public television, learning apps, games, art activities, and reading. Provide some sort of regular schedule where your student spends time in these type of activities each day. Lastly, around May 15^{th} , please look for a document that will help your student in preparation for grade-level expectations during the upcoming year. Around that time, we will release supply lists for next fall.

Personal Items

We recognize that your student may have personal items which need to be picked up from our schools. Also, if your student has a library book, owes lunch money, has borrowed a band instrument, we ask those be returned according to that schedule below. Remember, this is a brief time for pick up and return of items. It is important that we follow the schedule to remain in compliance with health suggestions.

Grades / Report Cards

Our staff will begin the process of finalizing grades near the first of May. They will be giving students every benefit of the doubt. For students who are at-risk, you will receive additional follow up from your school. For students needing IEP team meetings, you will receive additional follow up from that department.
