November 1 – Remote Learning Day

Since our last update, we have been approved for a **remote learning day drill**. On Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, we will transition to a remote learning day for all students in the district except Sophomores and Seniors. Sophomores and Seniors will report to school as usual for State ASVAB or ACT Testing.

**All students PK – 9 and 11 will receive remote instruction on November 1<sup>st</sup>.** Students should carry necessary technology (chromebooks) home on Friday the 28<sup>th</sup>. Teachers will provide assignments and instruction for students to complete. This remote drill will help us continue to keep our skills sharp in using technology as an instructional tool and to ensure that students are ready and knowledgeable and able to participate in remote learning. In some cases, the state may allow us to use remote learning days in lieu of inclement weather days through the winter.
